Higher Apprenticeship

Course Summary

This course is designed to enable students to gain qualifications required for a career in construction management.

The course will cover the following areas:

HNC/HND Units

- Health safety and welfare
- Design principles and application
- Science and mathematics
- Applied mathematics
- Environmental impact of construction
- Management principles and application
- Group projects in the construction industry
- Economics for construction
- Management for construction NVQ Units (Level 4)
- Monitoring quality standards in construction and the built environment
- Monitoring environmental factors and sustainability in construction and the built environment
- Managing the progress of projects in construction and the built environment
- Maintaining systems for health, safety, welfare and environmental protection in the workplace

Optional units include

- Planning and organising construction activities in the workplace
- Allocating and monitoring the use of plant, equipment or machinery in the workplace
- Developing and maintaining good occupational working relationships in the workplace
- Maintaining supplies of materials to meet project requirements in the workplace

NVQ Units (Level 5)

- Maintaining health, safety and welfare systems
- Developing working relationships
- Ensure compliance with legal, regulatory, ethical and social requirements
- Manage the environmental impact of work activities
- Monitoring environmental factors and sustainability
- 2/3 optional units relative to work occupation

This course is designed to enable students to gain a qualification required for a construction contracting career.

Between £2000 to £4000 depending on level and previous qualifications.
