

# Hairdressing Apprenticeship

## Course Summary

This course is designed to enable students to gain qualifications to start a career as a hairdresser. The qualification is credit based and allows flexibility to acquire and develop skill and knowledge needed for salon and industry.

The course will cover the following mandatory areas:

- **Make sure your own actions reduce risks to health and safety**
- **Give clients a positive impression of yourself and your organisation**
- **Advise and consult with clients**
- **Shampoo, condition and treat the hair and scalp**
- **Change hair colour**
- **Style and finish hair**
- **Set and dress hair**
- **Cut hair using basic techniques**

You will then choose from a wide selection of optional units choosing from topics such as:

- **Fulfil salon reception duties**
- **Promote additional services or products to clients**
- **Develop and maintain your effectiveness at work**
- **Plait and twist hair**
- **Perm and neutralise hair**
- **Attach hair to enhance a style**

## Functional Skills

Maths, English & ICT Level 1.

## ERR and PLTS

The candidate will learn about Employment Rights and Responsibilities and apply Personal Learning and Thinking Skills throughout their Apprenticeship.

## Length of Course

The Apprenticeship lasts for a minimum of 12 months to ensure the candidate can demonstrate significant work experience alongside their professional qualifications.

## Attendance

The Apprentice will attend college one day per week gaining training and knowledge to support the qualification. The rest of the qualification will be delivered in the workplace with the assessor visiting once every 4-6 weeks. If Functional Skills are required, weekly attendance will be required.

## How Much Will it Cost

The Apprenticeship is fully funded so we won't charge you anything. The only cost to you is the employment of the Apprentice – therefore paying their wage and associated costs.

We have grants available to support the recruitment of an Apprentice aged 16-24 of £1500 subject to eligibility checks. We also have further grants available to support recruitment of Salford residents subject to eligibility.

## Progression Routes

On completion of Level 2, progression onto NVQ Level 3 is advised.

## Facilities

Based in our hair and beauty department, we have fully furnished commercial salons to support our Apprenticeship provision.

We will provide the Apprentice with access to IT facilities including: use of software such as full suite of office software, electronic portfolio access, 24 hour remote on-line access to email account and learning resources, internet access, learning resources on Moodle.

## Recruitment

We will work with you to determine your requirements and provide full recruitment services - advertising through the National Apprenticeship Service, Indeed jobs website, social media and the college website. Our team of dedicated recruitment co-ordinators will assess, screen and interview potential Apprentices before we send them over to you for interview, saving you time and money in recruiting the right candidate.
